

ORDINANCE NO. 2714

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY FOR A SEWER EASEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Southern Pacific Company for the purpose of obtaining an easement for an underground sewer line crossing on the Southern Pacific Company's property, in connection with the expansion of the South Industrial Area Trunk Sewer in Albany.

Section 2: Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.


