

ORDINANCE NO. 2733

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2724, A PORTION THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Recital

Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2724, which excludes the Clerk-typist in the Police Department from the Classified Civil Service is in conflict with Chapter V Section 25 of the City Charter of Albany, Oregon.

The purpose of the following amendment is to eliminate the conflict between the City Charter and Ordinance No. 2724.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2724 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"All members of the Fire Department with the exception of the Chief and all members of the Police Department with the exception of the Chief shall be under classified Civil Service."

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany that the above amendment be made effective as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
