

ORDINANCE NO. 2805

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PORTION OF BLOCK 2, KURRE LAKESIDE TRACTS, CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 31st day of July 1958, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did duly pass Ordinance No. 2802 wherein it was provided that a Public Hearing would be held on the 27th day of August 1958, concerning the advisability of annexing a portion of Block 2, Kurre Lakeside Tracts, contiguous to the City of Albany, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the hearing was duly held on the 27th day of August 1958, and at that time the Council determined that notices of hearing had been duly given as provided in the said Ordinance and pursuant to the terms of 222.120 ORS, and

WHEREAS, the Council after the said hearing determined that the said portion of Block 2, Kurre Lakeside Tracts be annexed to the City of Albany, and the consent of the property owners has been filed giving their consent for the said annexation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That the following described property be and it is hereby annexed to the City of Albany to-wit:

Beginning South 1025' East 81.06 feet from the Southwest corner of Block 2, Kurre Lakeside Tracts, Section 5, township 11, 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, Linn County, Oregon;  
thence South 1025' East 200 feet to the Northwesterly right of way of the relocated Pacific Highway;  
thence along the said right of way on a 5669.58 foot radius to the right of the long chord of which bears South 59°25'40" West 410.74 feet a distance of 410.83 feet to a point 20 feet East of the West line of the Anderson Cox D.L.C. No. 49 in said township and range;  
thence North 1025' West parallel to the West line of said claim No. 49, a distance of 200 feet;  
thence North 59°25'40" East 410.74 feet to the place of beginning and containing 1.65 acres more or less.

Section 2: Whereas, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and, should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
