

ORDINANCE NO. 2810

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF WARNER AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did, by the adoption of Resolution No. 492 at the Council meeting held on the 13th day of August 1958, set the hour as 7:15 p.m. o'clock Pacific Standard Time on September 24, 1958 as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Warner Avenue, more particularly described in the said Resolution and did in the said Resolution direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law and in the said Resolution, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 24th day of September 1958 was duly held and no remonstrance having been filed with the City Recorder and no persons appearing objecting to the proposed vacation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That a portion of Warner Avenue, more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Warner Avenue between Block 1 and 2 Price's Second Addition and extending from the South terminus of said Avenue to a point which is 15 feet South of the North line of Lot 5, Block 2, and Lot 8, Block 1, Price's Second Addition

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Oregon.
