

ORDINANCE NO. 2814

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ROBERT BURNS DBA FORTMILLER-FREDERICKSON FUNERAL HOME AND FREDERICKSON AMBULANCE SERVICE, FOR AMBULANCE SERVICE PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2585 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2590 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Robert Burns doing business as Fortmiller-Frederickson Funeral Home, Incorporated, for the furnishing of ambulance service to the City of Albany pursuant to the terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 2585 until the termination of the Agreement on August 1, 1960.

Section 2: That Ordinance No. 2590 is hereby repealed.

Section 3: Whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany that this Ordinance become effective at the earliest possible time, therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its' passage by the Council and approval of the Mayor.
