

ORDINANCE NO. 2844

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE ENTIRE 29 PALMS ADDITION CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of April, 1959, at a regular Council Meeting, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did duly pass Ordinance No. 2839 wherein it was provided that a Public Hearing would be held on the 13th day of May, 1959, concerning the advisability of annexing the entire 29 Palms Addition contiguous to the City of Albany, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the hearing was duly held on the 13th day of May 1959, and at that time, the Council determined that the Notices of hearing had been given as provided in the said Ordinance, and pursuant to the terms of 222.120 ORS, and

WHEREAS, the Council after the said hearing determined that the said entire 29 Palms Addition be annexed to the City of Albany, and the consent of the property owners have been filed giving their consent for the said annexation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described property be and it is hereby annexed to the City of Albany, to-wit:

29 Palms Addition, Linn County, Oregon
as shown on the plats and records of the
Recorder of Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2: Whereas it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and, should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
