

Ordinance No. 2846

TITLE: An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2758, Section 8, thereof.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, application has been made by the Albany Sanitation Company for an increase in collection rates, as provided in Section 8 of Ordinance No. 2758, and after publication of the notice of public hearing was held on the 13th day of May, 1959, at 7:15 p.m., in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, at which time all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard on the proposed increase of residential rates of the collection of garbage in the City of Albany and no objection being heard and the Council being fully informed and of the opinion that the rates as applied for should be allowed, now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: ORDINANCE AMENDED

Section 8 of Ordinance No. 2758 is amended to read as follows:
Section 8: COLLECTION CHARGES:

The residential rates to be charged by all contractors for the collection of garbage and all rubbish shall not exceed those established by the following schedule:

Quantities of garbage or rubbish per collection (rates per month for number of collections per week set forth below).

- 30 Gallon can or less, - \$ 1.25
for one weekly collection
- In excess of 30 gallons and not exceeding
40 gallons, for one weekly collection - 1.40
- Exceeding 40 gallons, and including
60 gallons, for one weekly collection - 1.50
- Apartments
 - 3 or more apartment units -- - 1.00
per unit for one weekly collection
 - For two weekly collections - 1.25

The contractor shall charge business enterprises, such as hotels, restaurants, grocery stores, hospitals, lodges, boarding houses a reasonable fee, the same to be agreed upon according to a fair consideration of the amount and nature of the garbage and material to be disposed of in each individual instance. The charge for occasional pickup of debris removed from yards or buildings, other than garbage or refuse, shall be a reasonable charge of not less than 25¢ for each pick up and such additional charge as the size and nature of the particular articles to be hauled will justify.
