ORDINANCE NO. 2886

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY PURSUANT TO 222.120 ORS REGARDING ANNEXATION OF AREA 3 - SOUTH ALBANY ADDITION, ELKINS ADDITION, BISHOP ACRES AND ADJACENT AREA: SETTING A TIME FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

whereas, it has heretofore been determined to hold an election in an area herein described for the purpose of determining whether or not the residents in that area desire to be annexed to the City of Albany.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

That an election within the City of Albany for the purpose of annexing the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the present city limits line which is the intersection of the W. line of Rodgersdale Addition and the N. margin of 34th Ave., also known as Howard Cooper Drive; thence Westerly along the N. line of 34th Ave. to the £. right-of-way line of State Hwy. 99-E, thence Northerly along the £. right-of way line to the present city limits; thence Easterly; thence Southerly; thence Westerly; thence Southerly; thence Easterly; thence Northerly, thence Westerly; thence Northerly; thence Northerly; thence Easterly; thence Easterly; thence Easterly; thence Easterly; thence Easterly; thence Easterly; thence Southerly; thence Easterly; thence Southerly; thence So

shall be and is hereby dispensed with pursuant to and under the terms of 222.120 ORS.

Section 2: TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING - NOTICES

That there shall be held a public hearing as to the advisability of annexing Area 3 - South Albany Addition, Elkins Addition, Bishop Acres and adjacent area, described in Section 1, to the City of Albany on the 23rd day of December, 1959, at the hour of 7:15 o'clock p.m. in the City Hall, Albany, Oregon, and the City Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice of the said public hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation in said city once a week for two (2) successive weeks prior to the election and by posting a notice in four (4) public places for the same length of time setting forth the time and place of said hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purpose for which the hearing is held.

Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas, it is for the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this

matter of annexation of property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
