ORDINANCE NO. 2892

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE ASSESSMENTS AGAINST THE PROPERTY SPECIFICALLY BENEFITED BY CERTAIN SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

- 1. The sewer assessments as referred to in this Ordinance and previous Resolutions and Ordinances is *Freeway Addition Sanitary Sewer Extension No. 3".
- 2. Preliminary Resolutions and Ordinances prescribing the manner and extent of the improvements are set forth in Resolution Nos. 552 & 557 and in Ordinance Number 2723.
- 3. The assessments set forth in the following Ordinance are based upon the request and recommendation of the City Engineer's letter dated December 10, 1959, in compliance with Ordinance No. 2723.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: COST

The total cost of the sewer improvements for the Freeway Addition Sanitary Sewer Extention No. 3 is hereby determined to be \$1,903.77. The following represents a breakdown of the costs to be assessed against the property particularly benefited thereby:

Construction Cost 15% for engineering, legal & administrative costs \$1,655.45
