

ORDINANCE NO. 2902

TITLE: An Ordinance amending Section 4 of Ordinance No. 2854, providing for the time to commence construction for railroad crossings and maintenance thereof and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Section 4 of Ordinance 2854 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 4: COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION OF RAILROAD CROSSING AND MAINTENANCE THEREOF.

A railroad, upon receiving notice of designation of a railroad crossing upon their property in the City of Albany, shall within ninety (90) days after receipt of said notice, commence construction and proceed to maintain such designated railroad crossing in conformance with the type designated pursuant to the Resolution of the City Council. The railroad crossing shall be completed within ninety (90) days after notification has been given to the local agent of the railroad by the City Recorder as herein provided."

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany that this Ordinance become effective at the earliest possible time, therefore, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
