

ORDINANCE NO. 2911

TITLE: An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2758 by adding Section 14 wherein a penalty clause for violation of the Ordinance is provided and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Ordinance No. 2758 is hereby amended by the addition of Section 14 as follows:

"Section 14: PENALTY CLAUSE.

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days or by both such fine and imprisonment."

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and inhabitants of the City of Albany that this Ordinance become immediately operative, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
