

ORDINANCE NO. 2951

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF BAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did, by the adoption of Ordinance No. 2940 at the Council meeting held on the 8th day of February 1961, set the hour as 7:15 p.m. o'clock on March 22, 1961 as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Bain Street, more particularly described in the said ordinance and did in the said ordinance direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law and in the said ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 22nd day of March, 1961 was duly held, and parties were given opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That a portion of Bain Street, more particularly described as follows:

All of that part of Lots 1, 2 and 3 in Block 1, and all of that part of Lot 1 in Block 2, now included in public streets or roads, except that portion thereof presently included in Bain Street in Freeway Addition to the City of Albany in Linn County, Oregon, as designated and set-out in that certain survey sketch entitled "C.S. 6540, North Extension, Bain Street, Freeway Addition, Albany, Oregon, dated June, 1960, by Orris A. Carnegie, Linn County Surveyor",

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Oregon.
