

ORDINANCE NO. 2962

TITLE: Amendment to Ordinance No. 2754, providing for the addition of Section 3C as the same relates to driveways adjoining property which is zoned as industrial and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Ordinance No. 2754 is hereby amended by the addition of Section 3C to provide as follows:

"Section 3C: Notwithstanding any other provision in this Ordinance contained, there shall be no limitation on the width of curb cuts along any street, except a regularly designated arterial street as indicated on the planning maps of the City of Albany, when the streets are adjoining property that has been regularly zoned industrial. In the design of any street adjoining property which is zoned industrial, it shall be permissible to allow ingress and egress over the curbs bordering such street at any point without regard to specially designated driveway access. When said industrial property shall border upon a regularly designated arterial street, then the provision of Section 3B shall apply as to maximum driveway widths."

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Council President.
