

ORDINANCE NO. 3148

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE PRINCE & HENSHAW PROPERTY IN BLK. 1, SPRENGER'S SUPPLEMENTAL PLAT TO HAZELWOOD ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of September, 1964, at a special meeting of the Albany City Council, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did duly pass Ordinance No. 3145, wherein it was provided that a public hearing would be held on the 23rd day of September, 1964, concerning the advisability of annexing the area described as the Prince & Henshaw Property in Bk. 1, Sprenger's Supp. Plat to Hazelwood Addition, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the hearing was duly held on the 23rd day of September, 1964, and at that time the Council determined that the Notices of Hearing had been given as provided in the said Ordinance, and pursuant to the terms of ORS 222.110, 222.120 and 222.170, and

WHEREAS, the Council after said hearing determined that the area described as the Prince & Henshaw Property in Blk. 1, Sprenger's Supp. Plat to Hazelwood Addition, Linn County, Oregon, be annexed to the City of Albany, and the consent of the property owners having been filed giving their consent to the annexation,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DOORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described property be and is hereby annexed to the City of Albany, Oregon, to wit:

A portion of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, Block 1, Sprenger's Supp. Plat to Hazelwood Addition, being more particularly described as follows: Beginning N. 0° 15' W. 100.0 feet from the Northeast corner of Block 14, Hazelwood Addition and running thence N. 0°15' W. 251.45 feet to the North line of Block 1, Sprenger's Suppl Plat to Hazelwood Addition; thence 89°40' W. along said north line 100.0 feet; thence S. 0°15' E. 251.51 feet; thence N. 89°38' E. 100.0 feet to the place of beginning.

As an R-5 Residential Zone.

Section 2: That a copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and the number of the ordinance shall be noted on the official zoning map of the City of Albany.

Section 3: Whereas, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that **this matter** of annexation of the property herein described be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.


