

ORDINANCE NO. 3207

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY BETWEEN SHERMAN STREET AND SOUTH OAK STREET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 871, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1965, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on June 23, 1965, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of an alley between Sherman Street and South Oak Street, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 1965, was duly held and parties were given opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an alley between Sherman Street and South Oak Street in the City of Albany, more particularly described as follows:

The Alley between Sherman Street and South Oak Street, commencing on 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue for a distance of 300 feet South from 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Morningside Tracts, and Southern Addition of Morningside Tracts in the City of Albany, Oregon.

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public alleyway in the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 2: That the City of Albany does reserve an easement for utility purposes over that portion of the vacated alley in which the sanitary sewer line exists and retains the right to go upon such premises and install, replace or repair sewers, water lines, or other public utilities.
