

ORDINANCE NO. 3266

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1151, CITY OF ALBANY ORDINANCES, BEING AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SHADE AND ORNAMENTAL TREES OR SHRUBS OF WHATSOEVER KIND OR CHARACTER GROWING OR PROTRUDING OVER THE STREETS, SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS OR OTHER PUBLIC WAYS IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section I of Ordinance No. 1151 shall be amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation owning or occupying real property within the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, to permit any tree or shrub of any kind or character, ornamental or otherwise, growing in any street, alley or other public way, or in the parking contiguous to said property or growing upon said property so owned or occupied, to protrude or grow over any street, sidewalk, alley, or other public way in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, at a height less than 14 feet above the surface of any arterial street, 12 feet above any other street or alley and 8 feet above any sidewalk or any other public way.
