

ORDINANCE NO. 3434

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 3424, CITY OF ALBANY ORDINANCES, ANNEXING AN AREA ADJACENT TO SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD TRACKS AND NORTH SIDE OF WEST 34TH AVENUE TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That Ordinance No. 3424, City of Albany Ordinances, annexing an area adjacent to Southern Pacific Railroad Tracks and North side of West 34th Avenue to the City of Albany, Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Beg at SW cor DLC 53, T 11 S, R 3W; th Nly to Cl Albany Santiam Canal;
th N 17°30' E 7.1 ch; th Wly to E li SPRR main r/w; th Sly to S li DLC 53;
th Ely to beg. Exc pt in roads and railroad r/w.
Also exc. 11 3W 18C 101 demcr in Book 298, page 587, belonging to SPRR.

As an M-3 Zone

is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
