

ORDINANCE NO. 3442

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE DEFINING AND PUNISHING PERSONS WHO INVOLVE A MINOR CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS IN AN ACT OF A SEXUAL PERVERSION WITH HIMSELF OR ANOTHER PERSON, PROVIDING FOR PENALTY, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2156 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: PERVERSION - FINE.

Any person who lewdly fondles or manipulates the private parts of a child under the age of 18 years or who induces or permits a child under the age of 18 years to fondle or manipulate that person's private parts, or who by threats, commands or persuasion endeavors to induce any such child to commit any crime or to participate in any act of sexual perversion with himself or with another person, shall be punished by a fine of not more than FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not to exceed six (6) months or by both.

Section 2. MARRIED PERSONS.

Section 1 of this Ordinance shall not apply to acts between persons who are lawfully married to one another.

Section 3: REPEALED.

Ordinance No. 2156, City of Albany Ordinances, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 4: EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
