

ORDINANCE NO. 3491

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3484 ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE APPLICATION OF JUST AND EQUITABLE CHARGES FOR COMMERCIAL UNITS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

The effective date of the application of just and equitable charges for sewage disposal as the same pertains to commercial units established under Ordinance No. 3484, shall be the 1st day of October, 1970. Until October 1, 1970, those charges for commercial units now in existence shall remain in effect.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany is involved and therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance should become in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
