

ORDINANCE NO. 3514

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.24.080 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE AS THE SAME PERTAINS TO THE REQUIREMENT FOR KEEPING RECORDS BY JUNK DEALERS, SECOND HAND DEALERS OR PAWN BROKERS.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Section 5.24.080 of the Albany Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5.24.080. RECORDS. It shall be the duty of every junk dealer, second hand dealer, or pawn broker, to keep a record of all articles purchased, pledged, or received, which records shall be in a bound volume and shall show the name and description of the articles purchased, pledged, or received, the date and hour of the transaction, the price advanced, and the name, address, age and general description of the person selling or pledging, and which records shall be open to the inspection of any police officer of the city at all times during business hours; provided, however, that no second hand dealer shall be required to furnish such description of any property purchased from manufacturers or wholesale dealers having an established place of business, or of any purchase on the open market or secured from any person doing business and having an established place of business in the city. The record herein required to be kept shall be kept for a period of at least two (2) years from the date of purchase."
