

ORDINANCE NO. 3563

TITLE: An Ordinance amending Section 13.44.010 of the Albany Municipal Code by the addition of sub-section (a) (5) providing for impounding of a vehicle when possessor has been arrested for a crime and impoundment is desirable for the security of the vehicle, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: SUBSECTION 13.44.010 (a) (5) ADDED.

That Section 13.44.010 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended by adding to the said section the following:

"(a) (5) When a vehicle is found to be in the possession or control of a person arrested for a crime and such impoundment is desirable for the security of the vehicle."

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, the peace, health, and safety of the people of the city of Albany require that this Ordinance become immediately effective, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
