

ORDINANCE NO. 3585

TITLE: An Ordinance adopting amendments to the motor vehicle laws of the state of Oregon enacted by the 1971 Oregon Legislative Assembly and declaring emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 13.04 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended by the addition of Section 13.04040 to read as follows:

"Amendment - Adoption of 1971 Motor Vehicle Laws. The following enumerated Motor Vehicle Laws of the state of Oregon, together with all acts and amendments applicable to cities which were enacted by the 1971 Oregon Legislative Assembly are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this title:

Also, Chapter 564, Oregon Laws 1971, and Chapter 618, Oregon Laws 1971, as adopted and enacted into law covering the operation of motor vehicle."

Section 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Whereas, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the citizens of the city of Albany that this Ordinance become effective at the earliest possible time, therefore, this Ordinance should become effective immediately upon its passes by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
