

ORDINANCE NO. 3667

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.40.020 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE BY PROVIDING FOR CRIMINAL MISCHIEF IN THE SECOND AND THIRD DEGREES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT.

Section 7.40.020 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

"7.40.020(a) CRIMINAL MISCHIEF.

A person commits the crime of criminal mischief in the third degree if, with intent to cause substantial inconvenience to the owner or to another person, and having no right to do so or reasonable ground to believe that he has such right, he tampers or interferes with property of another.

(b) A person commits the crime of criminal mischief in the second degree if he commits the crime defined in subparagraph (a) of this section and in addition thereto the damages to the property are in an amount exceeding ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) or having no right to do so or no reasonable grounds to believe that he has such right, he intentionally damages property of another in any amount, or he recklessly damages property of another in an amount exceeding ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00).

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the peace, health, and safety of the people of the city of Albany require that this Ordinance become immediately effective, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
