

ORDINANCE NO. 3788

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF SECTION 10.08.030 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE, PARTICULARLY SUBPARAGRAPHS (a) AND (b) OF SAID SECTION AS THE SAME PERTAINS TO CHARGES FOR SEWER USERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Subsections (a) and (b) of Section 10.08.030 are amended to read as follows:

"The just and equitable charges, based on the benefit received, aforesaid, are established, determined and declared to be as follows:

SS_C equals 300 ppm"

Section 2: Emergency Declared

Whereas, it is in the interest of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany that this ordinance shall take immediate effect. Now, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect on its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
