ORDINANCE NO. 3847

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DESIGNATED BICYCLE PATHS BY RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL, LIMITING THE USE OF BICYCLE PATHS TO PEDESTRIANS AND NONMOTORIZED VEHICLES.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

The City Council of the City of Albany shall, by Resolution, establish designated paths for pedestrian and/or bicycle use only within the City of Albany.

Section 2:

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motorized vehicle upon any designated pedestrian and/or bicycle path within the City of Albany.

Section 3:

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to those penalties provided in Chapter 1.04 of the Albany Municipal Code.
