ORDINANCE NO. 4131

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13.44.020 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE PROVIDING FOR TOWING AND STORAGE CHARGES FOR VEHICLES REMOVED FROM CITY STREETS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 1: Section 13.44.020 of the Albany municipal code is amended to read as follows:

"Section 13.44.020-Towing and Storage Charges. Any vehicle removed from the street by a police officer or under the direction of a police officer pursuant to Section 13.44.010 shall be subject to a tow-away charge of such amount as shall be charged by a towing company doing business in the city of Albany which sum shall be paid to the city recorder before the vehicle is released to the custody of the owner. The owner of the vehicle shall further be required to pay a reasonable storage charge as shall be charged by a vehicle storage company that is providing storage for the vehicle."


Section 2: Emergency Declared.

In as much as the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the city of Albany requires that this ordinance take force immediately, and an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect upon its passage by the council and approved by the mayor.
