

ORDINANCE NO. 4385

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TERMINATING A NONEXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE FOR THE OPERATION OF AN AMBULANCE BUSINESS WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY GRANTED TO MEDICAL SERVICES, INC., AN OREGON CORPORATION, BY ORDINANCE #4308, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a nonexclusive franchise for the operation of an ambulance business was granted to Medical Services, Inc., an Oregon corporation, by Ordinance #4308, City of Albany ordinances, effective August 24, 1979, and

WHEREAS, Section 5.16.050 of the Albany Municipal Code provides that a franchise may be revoked by the City Council when a franchisee shall have abandoned its operation of the ambulance business for a period of one (1) or more days, and

WHEREAS, Medical Services, Inc. have not been in operation of an ambulance business in the City of Albany commencing at 10:00 a.m., on July 11, 1980, and said abandonment of the operation continued for more than 24 hours, thereby providing just cause for revocation of the franchise granted under Ordinance #4308, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

The franchise granted to Medical Services, Inc., an Oregon corporation, under Ordinance #4308, City of Albany ordinances, is hereby cancelled, and all rights and privileges which were granted under said franchise are hereby terminated forthwith.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE:

Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately effective and in full force upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
