

ORDINANCE NO. 4440

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4420, BY SHOWING THE GRANTEE IN SAID ORDINANCE AS THE BURLINGTON NORTHERN (OREGON-WASHINGTON) INC.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4420 was adopted on the 27th day of May, 1981, and therein granted to the Oregon Electric Railroad Company, a corporation, the right and privilege to construct, maintain, operate, and use railroad track and operate cars and locomotives in and through the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, Oregon Electric Railroad Company has merged with the Burlington Northern, Inc. and the proper name of the grantee in said Ordinance should be Burlington Northern (Oregon-Washington), Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: Ordinance No. 4420, as the same amended Ordinance No. 3887 is further amended in the following particulars:

That in all sections of said Ordinance where the words appear, "Oregon Electric Railroad Company, a corporation," there shall be substituted in place thereof the following: "Burlington Northern (Oregon-Washington), Inc."
