

ORDINANCE NO. 4633

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ALBANY MUNICIPAL SECTION 7.08.060, TAMPERING WITH ANIMALS USED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Albany Municipal Code Section 7.08.060, Tampering with animals used for law enforcement purposes, is hereby established:

7.08.060 Tampering with Animals Used for Law Enforcement Purposes. It is unlawful for any person to torture, torment, beat, kick, strike, choke, cut, stab, stone, shoot, mutilate, injure, disable, kill, or tamper with any animal while it is being caged, kennelled, transported, exhibited, exercised, or used in discharging or attempting to discharge any lawful duty or function or power of office by any police officer or his representative for any police agency.
