

ORDINANCE NO. 5182

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 5.12, TAXICABS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Albany Municipal Code, 5.12, Taxicabs, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.12.010 Definitions.

(9) "Alcoholic Liquor" means any alcoholic beverage containing more than one-half of one percent alcohol by volume, and every liquid or solid, patented or not, containing alcohol, and capable of being consumed by a human being (ORS 471.005).

5.12.040 Taxicabs.

(5) No taxicab driver or operator shall use a taxicab for the transportation or delivery of an alcoholic beverage. This section shall not prohibit the transportation of a person, for hire, when such person lawfully possesses an alcoholic beverage.


(6) No taxicab driver or operator shall accept compensation, in any form, for the transportation or delivery of any alcoholic beverage, except as allowed in (5) above.

Section 2. Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
