

ORDINANCE NO. 5371

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A STREET NAME CHANGE FOR A PORTION OF SEVENTH AVENUE SE TO SANTIAM ROAD SE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Community Development Director initiated the street name change (SR-04-98) following the process identified in section 12.640 of the Albany Development Code; and

WHEREAS, staff determined that the street name change was necessary to eliminate confusion due to the realignment of Santiam Road in the subject area as a result of the Pacific Boulevard/Ninth Avenue Couplet project; and

WHEREAS, notices of the tentative staff decision were mailed to affected property owners on June 17, 1998, as required by Section 12.630(3a) of the Albany Development Code; and

WHEREAS, no requests were received by the Planning Division of the City of Albany for a public hearing on the proposed street name change; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council on July 8, 1998, voted to approve the proposed Street Name Change as shown on the attached "Exhibit A."

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That portion of Seventh Avenue SE lying between Cleveland Street SE and Burkhart Street SE is hereby changed to Santiam Road SE.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of this city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
