## ORDINANCE NO. 5540

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.84 160(2) OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO NOXIOUS VEGETATION, WEEDS, AND GRASS WHICH CONSTITUTES A FIRE HAZARD OR VISION CLEARANCE HAZARD AND DECLARING THEM A NUISANCE

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there are typographical errors in Section 7.84.160(2) which documents the distances at which noxious vegetation are determined to be a public nuisance; and

WHEREAS, the distances need to be changed in order to correctly reflect the intention of this section in the Albany Municipal Code

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. AMC Section 7.84.160. Noxious Vegetation, Weeds, and Grass which Constitute a Fire Hazard or Vision Clearance Hazard are Declared a Nuisance.

- (2) It is hereby determined and declared that weeds, grass, or other noxious vegetation over 15 inches in height are determined to be a vision clearance hazard and a public nuisance whenever they are at any of the locations set forth below
  - (a) Within 50 feet of the facing edge of the curb of any improved street or road; or
  - (b) Within 50 feet of the edge of the pavement on any paved, but not fully improved street or road; or
  - (c) Within 50 feet of the traveled way on any unimproved dirt or gravel street or road.
