

RESOLUTION NO. 100

Whereas there have been several areas that are adjacent to the City of Albany that could be properly annexed to the City,

Whereas such annexation should properly be made at an early date and before proposed main sewers are constructed,

Whereas numerous petitions have been made designating certain areas that are adjacent to the city that desire to be annexed and that Council does determine that all such areas that are adjacent to the City of Albany in which any expression of the desire to be annexed has been made to the council be petition or otherwise,

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED that the territory hereinafter described and being adjacent to the City of Albany, Oregon, is considered and determined as being a proper area to be annexed to the City of Albany and that such question of annexation of this territory should be submitted to the qualified voters of the City of Albany and the qualified voters residing in the territory so designated hereafter;

Beginning at the southwest corner of the presently constituted city limits which is the southwest corner of the Bureau of Mines' property and running thence west a distance of 260 feet; running thence northerly and parallel with the presently constituted city limits to a point where this line if extended would intersect the north boundary line of the County Road which is known as the South Albany-Corvallis Road which point is on the south boundary line of Hazelwood Addition; running thence northeasterly along the north line of said County Road to where it intersects the west line of Broadway and running thence northeasterly to the southwest corner of Block 1, Albany Heights Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon; running thence southerly along the present west city limits of the City of Albany which is the west boundary line of Bureau of Mines' Property to the point of beginning.
