

RESOLUTION NO. 368

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has estimated the population within the city limits to be approximately 14,091 persons and such estimate has been filed with the State Board of Census, and


WHEREAS, the State Board of Census has subsequently certified the population of Albany to be 12,300 persons, said certification having been published April 15, 1956, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the city administration that the population estimate of 12,300 as certified by the State Board of Census is too low and that as a result the city might be unduly penalized by reason of loss of a proportionate amount of state shared revenues, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Manager hereby are authorized and directed to proceed with an actual count of persons residing within the limits of the City of Albany for the purpose of establishing the actual census of population of the City of Albany and to secure the necessary information and material therefore,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such census taking authorized herein be completed not later than June 30, 1956.
