

R E S O L U T I O N N O . 408

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council deem it expedient to construct, after, repair, or improve the following streets, alleys, sidewalks and drains of which all or a part thereof shall be assessed to the property directly benefitted:

STREETS

Jackson Street, Queen Avenue to 18th Avenue

9th Avenue, Jackson Street to Madison Street

23rd Avenue, Oak Street to E. boundary of Morningside Tracts

24th Avenue, Oak Street to E. boundary of Morningside Tracts

Oak Street, 23rd Avenue to N. boundary of Morningside Tracts

Liberty Street, 25th Avenue, North to existing improved street

29th Avenue, Highway 99 to S.P.R.R. track right-of-way.

(29th Avenue is not a designated street, the centerline of 29th Avenue is described as follows: commencing at a point N. $0^{\circ} 54\frac{1}{2}'$ W. 1741.04 feet from the NW corner of the Truett Davis DLC 38, T 11 S., R 4 W and running thence N $88^{\circ} 54\frac{1}{2}'$ E. to the S.P.R.R. right of way.

Alley in Polasek Addition

Alley in Block 30, of Montieth's Addition

DRAINAGE, CURB & GUTTER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

21st Avenue, Elm Street to Walnut Street

SIDEWALKS

Queen Avenue, North & South side from Marion Street to Sherman St.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer be directed to prepare a report on the above proposed improvements, such report to be in compliance with Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2723, City of Albany Ordinances.
