

R E S O L U T I O N N O. 460

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, that it is in the public interest to initiate such proceedings as are necessary to vacate, a portion of Denver Street also known as Sherman Street, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All of the portion of Denver Street, also known as Sherman Street, which lies North of the intersection of 28th Avenue and between Lots 19 and 2, and 18 and 1 of the First Addition to Rodgers Acres, Linn County, Oregon.

The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice of a Public Hearing on the proposed vacation of the street as above described to be held in the Council Chambers of the City Hall on the 23rd day of April, 1958, at the hour of 7:15 p.m., Pacific Standard Time, by publishing notice thereof once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Albany, and by posting notice thereof at each end of the proposed vacation and at two (2) places within the area vacated within five (5) days of the first publication. Said notice to set forth the time, place and purpose of said hearing and to contain a description of the street proposed to be vacated.
