

RESOLUTION NO. 566

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2751 requires that all parking restrictions shall be established by resolution and shall specify the lawful time limit, and

WHEREAS, the Parking Commission, after conducting an investigation, made recommendations pertaining to the establishment of 12 minute parking zones during the full twenty-four hours of a day in order to provide for the safety and convenience of those persons making deposits at banks at other than regular banking hours,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the following locations shall be established as 12 minute parking zones during the full twenty-four hours of any day:

1. The first meter space south of First Ave. on the west side of Broadalbin St.
2. The first meter space west of Ellsworth St. on the north side of First Ave.
3. The first meter space south of Second Ave. on the east side of Ellsworth St.
