

RESOLUTION NO. 630


WHEREAS, a traffic hazard now exists on U. S. Highway 99 E in the vicinity of Waverly Lake at the point where the highway is reduced from four lanes to two lanes,

AND WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the safety of the people using the highway in the vicinity abovementioned, that the portion of the highway now consisting of two lane traffic be widened to accommodate four lanes of traffic,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that the State of Oregon by and through its Oregon State Highway Commission widen U. S. Highway 99E in the vicinity of Waverly Lake area in the City of Albany from two lanes to four lanes of traffic.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Oregon State Highway Commission indicating the desires of the people of the City of Albany.
