

RESOLUTION NO. 657

WHEREAS the citizens of the City of Albany have requested the City Council to pursue an urban renewal project for the City of Albany and consideration being given, now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that an advisory Urban Renewal Committee be appointed, with one member to be selected by each councilman, one member by the Mayor, and one member each of the Planning & Zoning Commission and the Parking Commission to be selected by their respective chairman.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this committee shall be charged with the following duties:

1. Determine the boundaries of a feasible urban renewal project.
2. To prepare all material necessary for a workable program.
3. To study public improvements that may be accomplished as a part of the urban renewal project and financed by city funds.
4. To study the possibility of the acquisition of open land for waterfront beautification.
5. To make recommendations to the City Council concerning all these matters with March 15, 1962 as a deadline for completion of these studies and recommendation.

Upon completion of said duties, the committee shall file a report with the City Council.
