

RESOLUTION NO. 771

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, U.S.A.,
EXTENDING AN INVITATION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, WESTERN AUSTRALIA,
TO BECOME A SISTER-CITY IN THE PEOPLE-TO-PEOPLE PROGRAM AND
INVITING THE PEOPLE OF ALBANY, OREGON, U.S.A., TO PARTICIPATE IN
SAID PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, THE "People-to-People Program" was established by
the President of the United States at the White House in 1956 to
establish greater friendship and understanding between the peoples
of the United States and other nations through the medium of direct
personal contact, and

WHEREAS, to implement this program Albany and other cities
in the United States have been requested by the American Municipal
Association to affiliate with a city abroad of similar character-
istics and mutual interest, and

WHEREAS, Albany through its Council does recognize and endorse
this program with the hope that it will lead to a lasting friendship
between the people of Albany, Oregon, U.S.A., and Albany, Western
Australia; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED,

THAT the Albany City Council on behalf of the People of Albany,
Oregon, U.S.A., hereby extends an invitation to the Government and
people of the City of Albany, Western Australia, to participate with
Albany, Oregon, U.S.A., as its Sister-City in the "People-to-People
Program" for the purpose of creating good will and understanding
between the people of our two great nations;

THAT the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, U.S.A., is
hereby authorized to act as official representative of Albany to
carry out this program and

THAT copies of this resolution are to be sent to the Mayor and
Council of the City of Albany, Western Australia; the American
Municipal Association; the United States Department of State and
the Embassy of Australia.
