

RESOLUTION NO. 828

WHEREAS, the State Speed Control Board of the State of Oregon, has proposed speed zones for the Albany-Junction City Highway in the City of Albany, Oregon, as follows:

<u>Albany-Jun. City Hwy-Southbound</u> The north City Limits of Albany	The end of the Interchange	45 MPH
<u>Albany-Jun. City Hwy-Northbound</u> The north City Limits of Albany	The end of the Interchange	45 MPH
<u>Albany-Jun. City Hwy.-Two-Way</u> The end of the Interchange	200 ft. south of Cox Creek	45 MPH
200 ft. south of Cox Creek	200 ft. east of Ellsworth	35* MPH
200 ft. east of Ellsworth	0.14 mile South of Queen St.	45 MPH
0.14 mile south of Queen St.	The Albany City Limits, 400' north of 39 th Avenue	50 MPH
The Albany City Limits, 200' north of 34 th Avenue	The Albany City Limits 350' south of 34 th Avenue	50 MPH


* Except that between 400 ft. east of Columbus St. and 200 ft. west of Columbus Street the designated speed shall be 20 MPH during the hours of school crossings as per the provisions of Subsection 1.a. of ORS 483.104.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Albany that the proposed speeds be recommended to the State Speed Control Board for adoption and that the same be adopted by the City of Albany, Oregon.
