

ESTABLISHMENT OF TAXI FARES UNDER SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2334

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Ordinance No. 2334 as amended provides that taxi fares shall be established by Resolution of the Council, now therefore

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that the following fares are hereby established for taxicabs operating within the City of Albany:

Forty cents (\$0.40) for the first one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) mile

Ten cents (\$0.10) for each one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) mile after the first one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) mile.

Ten cents (\$0.10) for each additional passenger over the age of twelve (12) years.

Waiting time shall be charged for at the rate of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each hour.


There shall be no charge for hand luggage of passengers
