

BE IT RESOLVED, that the abstract of votes of the Council of the City of Albany, as to the ballots cast in the Special Election, held August 15, 1968, be and the same is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the ballots cast on the measures in the Special Election of August 15, 1968, are as follows:

Referred to the legal voters of the City of Albany by the City Council: Shall the City of Albany levy a special continuing five (5) year tax levy of not to exceed \$71,000.00 per year outside the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution, beginning with the tax year 1968-69, to provide for the payment of salaries for additional employees in the law enforcement department of the City of Albany, a supplementing of existing salaries of law enforcement personnel, purchasing additional equipment in the law enforcement department? The rate of levy deemed necessary to raise the above amount is estimated as follows:

For 1968-69, the sum of 67¢ per thousand dollars of true cash value of taxable property within the city;

For 1969-70, the sum of 67¢ per thousand dollars of true cash value of taxable property within the city;

For 1970-71, the sum of 64¢ per thousand dollars of true cash value of taxable property within the city;

For 1971-72, the sum of 62¢ per thousand dollars of true cash value of taxable property within the city;

For 1972-73, the sum of 61¢ per thousand dollars of true cash value of taxable property within the city;
