


RESOLUTION NO. 1243

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon that there shall be initiated such proceedings as are necessary to vacate a portion of a street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, which is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All of Oak Street lying South of Salem Avenue and extending Southerly to North r/w line of Southern Pacific Railroad tracks and RESERVING a 15 ft. sanitary sewer easement to the City of Albany on either side of the existing sewer, said sewer line being 36 ft. West of the East property line of Oak Street as dedicated in Abbey's Addition to the City of Albany; ALSO RESERVING a sanitary sewer easement to the City of Albany 15 ft. in width, the center line is as follows: Begin at a Manhole which is South, 166 ft. m/1 from the South line of Salem Road and 36 ft. West of the East line of said Oak Street; th Easterly 36 ft. to the East line of said Oak Street.

The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice of a public hearing on the proposed said vacation of street as above described, to be held in the Council Chambers at the City Hall on the 22nd day of April, 1970, at the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock by publication of notice thereof once a week for four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Albany and by posting notice thereof at each end of the proposed vacation and at two places within the area vacated within five days of first publication date, said notice to set forth the time, place and purpose of said hearing and to contain a description of the street proposed to be vacated.
