RESOLUTION NO. 2126

TITLE: A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING POLICY FOR COUNCIL EXAMINATION OF ALL PUBLIC WORK PROJECTS OTHER THAN ROUTINE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR

WHEREAS, all public work projects required expenditure of public funds either local, state or federal in nature, and

WHEREAS, public support depends on the popular acceptance of all City operations and, particularly, public improvement projects, and

WHEREAS, construction of paths, pavements, berms, barriers, drains, piping systems and buildings for public usage may be objectionable to certain citizens of the City of Albany for reasons that are not readily apparent to City management and the Council, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY:

1. That all public work projects other than routine maintenance and repair be subject to the public hearing process;
2. That the City Manager shall report to the City Council the acquisition of all necessary property ownership and rights-of-way prior to the beginning of any public work project; and
3. That the City Manager shall submit to the City Council an Environmental Impact statement covering any public work projects other than routine maintenance and repair prior to the beginning of the project.
4. Street and sewer projects, the costs of which are assessed to benefited properties, shall only require those hearings as set forth in the Oregon Revised Statutes.
