TITLE: A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY FOR ACQUISITION OF
STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, the City of Albany, by and through its agents, has attempted to
acquire certain public right-of-way for the purpose of street construction;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has determined that the reasonable value of the
property to be taken for the construction of the street is the sum of Eleven
Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00), which sum has been offered to the owner of said
property, and the owner has refused to convey said property to the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the City of Albany, and it is hereby found,
that the taking of the real property hereinafter described is necessary and in
the public interest, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that condemnation proceedings
be instituted against the owner of the following described property:

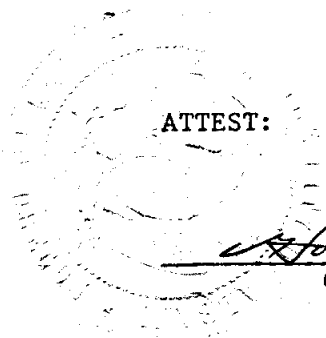
A parcel of land lying in Block 1, GLENDORR, Linn County, Oregon
and being the westerly 6 feet of that property described in that
deed to Thomas J. and Margaret D. Hash, recorded in MF Vol. 162,
Page 739 of Linn County Records.

The parcel of land to which this description applies contains
354 square feet, more or less.
