

RESOLUTION NO. 2326

WHEREAS, on January 27, 1982, the City Council approved increases in schedules for certain building permit fees; and


WHEREAS, the proposed 1982-86 Capital Improvements Program anticipates substantial increases in both sewer connection fees and parkland fees; and

WHEREAS, the costs of building permits and sewer connection and parkland fees adversely affect the local homebuilding and remodeling industry which continues to bear an excessive burden imposed by the depressed national economy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a moratorium extending to July 1, 1983, be placed upon the approved building permit fee increases retroactive to February 28, 1982, and upon increases in sewer connection and parkland fees which may be approved by the City Council as essential parts of the 1982-86 Capital Improvements Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said moratorium be continued until repealed by the City Council.
