

RESOLUTION NO. 2576


WHEREAS, voters in Albany and throughout Linn County will vote by mail on November 5 to approve the sale of general obligation bonds by Linn County to finance the cost of constructing a new jail and sheriff's office and the remodeling of courtrooms; and

WHEREAS, the new jail will include space for persons charged or convicted of violating city ordinances and, thus, will enable the City to close its jail and avoid the cost of constructing a jail meeting all state and federal requirements for its own use; and

WHEREAS, the existing county jail, limited by court order to not have more than 24 prisoners, does not provide space for all persons who should be detained either to assure their appearance at a trial or to punish them upon conviction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the voters in Albany are urged to approve the sale of bonds by Linn County by voting "YES" when mail ballots are received next week.
