

RESOLUTION NO. 2688

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany has authorized a contract with the engineering consulting firm of CH<sub>2</sub>M-Hill for the purpose of determining equitable sewer utility rates for the users of the City's waste treatment plant and distribution system; and

WHEREAS, the rates recommended by CH<sub>2</sub>M-Hill would increase the revenues for fiscal year 1987-88 to the Sewer Fund by approximately 10% over revenues received for fiscal year 1986-87; and

WHEREAS, the exact rates by user classification will not be determined until June 10, 1987; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Albany City Council to give advance notice of these proposed rate adjustments at the earliest possible date.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council intends to adjust the sewer utility rates in accordance with the recommendations of the City's consulting engineers, CH<sub>2</sub>M-Hill so that revenues would increase approximately 10% over the revenues received fiscal year 1986-87; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the rate adjustments would be effective July 1, 1987.
