
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALBANY FIRE DEPARTMENT TO EXTINGUISH FIRES IN UNPROTECTED AREAS AND TO BILL OWNER OF PROPERTY FOR COST OF EXTINGUISHING FIRE.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Fire Department may respond outside its authorized fire protection area to provide fire suppression services, and such properties receiving such services do not contribute monetarily to the City of Albany for fire protection nor are they covered by a fire department in which the City of Albany has a Mutual Aid Agreement with.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that as allowed in O.R.S. 476.280 the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the Fire Chief and the representatives of the Fire Chief to extinguish uncontrolled fires that are found to be burning in areas situated outside of the boundaries of the City or district and that are causing or may cause an undue jeopardy to life or property; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after controlling said fire a bill for fire suppression services will be sent to the property owners or lessees for fire suppression in accordance with O.R.S. 476.290.
